NOVA SCOTIA FREEMASONS' BURSARY**

The **NOVA SCOTIA FREEMASONS' BURSARY** has been established by the **MASONIC FOUNDATION OF NOVA SCOTIA** in conjunction with local Masonic Lodges in Nova Scotia. In the local Guysborough area, namely **EASTERN LIGHT LODGE NO. 72 A.F. & F.M.**

1. The Award shall be known as the "NOVA SCOTIA FREEMASONS' BURSARY."
2. The Principal Objective of the Award is to provide Financial Assistance to worthy students to undertake post-secondary education, in keeping with the Masonic Mission to practice charity.
3. The Award is to be administered by a committee appointed by the local constituent lodge, namely EASTERN LIGHT LODGE NO. 72 A.F. & F.M., who shall be responsible for selecting candidates to receive the Award.
4. Payment of the Bursary awarded shall be made by the FOUNDATION directly to the university or community college selected by the recipient upon the receipt of an invoice from the university or community college. (See list of approved Atlantic Canadian universities and community colleges attached.)
5. Bursary recipients will be presented with a "LETTER OF INTENT" by a representative of Eastern Light Lodge No. 72 at the graduation ceremonies.
6. For the year 2017, the Bursary shall be one (1) \$500.00 Award per candidate.

**AWARD CRITERIA**

1. The Award is available to all Graduating students of SAERC, who attended Mulgrave Memorial Education Centre, are residents of Nova Scotia, who have been accepted or are likely to be accepted at a recognized Atlantic Canada university or community college. IT IS NOT A REQUIREMENT THAT GRADUATES BE RELATED OR CONNECTED TO A MASONIC MEMBER.
2. Candidates shall be selected on the basis of:
  - a. Academic achievement
  - b. Probability of success in university or community college studies
  - c. Financial need.
3. Applications must contain the following information:
  - a. A letter indicating future career plans, the value of community involvement, and reasons an award should be presented to him/her
  - b. Verification of acceptance (or possible acceptance) from a recognized Atlantic Canadian university or community college
  - c. Record of Academic Standing
  - d. Social Insurance Number.
4. Deadline for Receipt of Application is May 22, 2017. Applications received after this date will not be considered.
