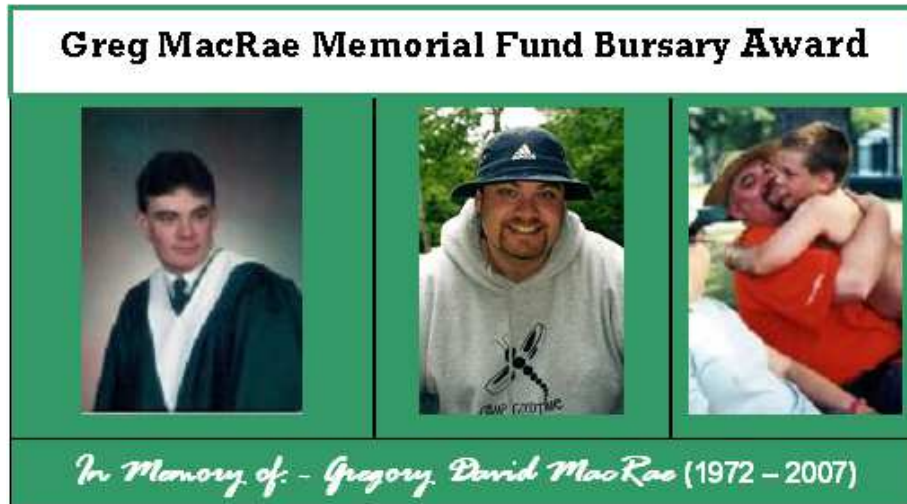


Greg MacRae Memorial Fund Bursary: 2016/17

Greg passed away on March 7, 2007 as a result of complications from his nearly ten-year battle with cancer. He was an amazing son, brother, husband, cousin and friend.
